Prayer Guide

DETAILS ST Prayer-walking is praying on-site with insight. There is power in being physically present in our

communities as we ask for God's Spirit to move. You are an ambassador for Jesus! You may have neighbors who have problems that don't know God is able and willing to help.

•Decide a prayer walking route. Don't feel limited to your street or neighborhood. Go wherever God may lead.

•Do you need a prayer partner to walk and pray with you? You can also imagine that Jesus is walking with you.

•Does God bring a song to mind? Sing it as you walk! Are you thinking of a scripture? Speak it out loud as a promise over your street.

•If you pass a neighbor outside, don't hesitate to stop and engage them. Wave, smile, & talk to people on the street. You never know if it is a divine appointment!

IDEAS ST

Pray people would be connected to God.

- Understand & know how much God loves them.
- Look to Jesus for their salvation.
- God would create a desire in their hearts to look to His word for answers.
- Ask the Lord for transformation and His Spirit works in and through them.

Pray people would live in community.

- Ask God to draw them into a church that will love them and care for their needs.
- Pray for relationships that will strengthen and encourage them to live as God desires.
- Pray for people who might be isolated and alone.

Pray people would be compassionate.

- Intercede for peace and mercy to flow through relationships in the community.
- If there are people in need, ask God to give you eyes to meet those needs.
- There are people all around with broken marriages, substance abuse, wayward kids, and burdens great. Ask God for deliverance.
